Here's one example. The implementation of a “Willie Lynch Doctrine”; the breaking up of families of enslaved Africans, cut off from their culture and spiritual practices to create perpetual enslavement of African Americans through chattel slavery, peonage, Black Codes, convict leasing, segregation and Jim Crow laws has been found to be untrue but you cannot look at the black community and see that; even if the practice of breaking up families wasn't organized to that extent, the end result is the insidious racism that we see today.

This is the same situation with many of the countries in Africa and other countries of color who are indebted to the IMF (International Monetary Fund) and whose payments of just the interest due, are so high that they can’t maintain life sustaining social programs. The multi color “Terror” alerts as a result of the U.S governments “false flag” operation in their destruction of the World Trade Center towers on 9/11/01” to create a new “Pearl Harbor” have many of us living on a life line of fear. This “war on terror” is nothing more than a “war on freedom”. The loss and or infringement of civil liberties are imminent, setting the stage for Marshall Law. In the words of Dr. Cornel West, “You’re feeling unsafe, unprotected, subject to random violence, and hated. You’ve been “Niggerized”. Armed with this powerful tool he has steadily, defied and manipulated the law of causality to maintain control and develop codes and systems of meaning that capture and mine the life force, through the orchestration of meanings. The monotheistic system of religion has become business in disguise; "stealing in the name of the Lord". The perception of a "God" or "Creator" disempowers our innate consciousness of right versus wrong and changes the vitality of our thinking; calming, non-assertive and tolerant of present circumstances. The brainwashing is complete and we have bought into the lie of, inequality, fast food, super sizing, and the quick fix, to become a nation of "it's not my problem", people.

Through the media brainwashing and Miseducation we are all being kept detached from our true humane identity. The corporate control of the media has shaped our reality through a steady diet of vicarious alternatives, to fill this void of powerlessness and diminish our interactive activity. In 2004, America reelected the worst president in the history of the U.S.A who's agenda is counter to the basic needs of the people but who's anger appeals to and satisfies the vicarious needs of the populace who profit on the religious based "moral values" that maintain their status quo based upon racism, colonization and the institution of White privilege which has brought us to these catastrophic times. Just as the inhaled cigarette smoke, changes the composition of the old air in our lungs and the digestion of food alters the chemical composition of the blood in our veins, so does the positive acknowledgement and respect of the law of causality changes the composition of our past deeds or karma thereby changing the intensity of it’s effect in our present and future lives.

By acknowledging the root cause of all of our ills as disrespect or slander of the law of causality we can begin the process of altering the effects in the past, present and the future. This is the essence of “Why I Practice Nichiren Shoshu True Buddhism”. Within the practice of Nichiren Shoshu True Buddhism (the correct tool for the age that we are living in) is a self sustaining delivery system where you will attain wisdom and experience an abundance of opportunities that enable you to change our inner environment, and that of all living beings and their ancestors, which produces a cause to attain a life of tranquility, enlightenment, excellence and freedom from fear in this, and all future existences. There are no coincidences in life, you will learn to recognize when you, and others are actively or

passively dampening down the truth to continue the spread of lies that slander the Law.

We accelerate our natural pathology through various addictions that affect our chemical and mental balance rather than to face the challenges “clean and sober”. This is where the power of faith in your abilities enters and your reliance on old self-destructive habits rooted in fear begins to fade away. The Universe, all existence and the eternal law that makes us all one has the same eternal name which is Myoho Renge Kyo, and this name is the tool with which to acknowledge the universe, the law and each other: We show our respect, through the positive demonstration of chanting, Nam Myoho Renge Kyo.
